The New Hampshire State Liquor Commission (NHSLC) is in receipt of your Right-to-Know request dated December 27, 2013. You have requested documents pertaining to the following:

- A detailed summary of all non-inventory assets: including but not limited to the address and assessed value of all buildings; the year, make model and Kelley Blue Book value of all automobiles; and all other non-inventory assets owned and/or maintained by the NHSLC.
- Documentation relating to all NHSLC Outlets located in a shared building; including but not limited to the owner of the building, and business name of other businesses in the complex.
- Documentation relating to all NHSLC Outlets located with 1,000 feet of a school, child care facility, church, synagogue, playground, and/or hospital.

As a preliminary matter, please note RSA 91-A does not require the NHSLC to generate documents responsive to your request.
